Dear Parents/Carers,

I am delighted to inform you that we are now in a position to re-launch our School Bank. When we originally launched the School Bank last year, any child who opened a school bank account received £1 to start their account off. Several children took up this offer and have become regular savers. However, we know from our records that there are still a number of children who have not opened an account and have not received their £1 free contribution.

As a result, we are re-launching our school bank with the same criteria as before; any child who opens a new bank account will receive a £1 donation from school to start their savings off and they will also receive a free 'piggy bank'. All parents/carers need to do is bring their photo ID and proof of address together with the birth certificate or Child Benefit letter for the child to open the account – staff will be on hand to help with the completion of forms. Below are the dates that the school bank will be open (3.30pm – 4pm) for the rest of the academic year:-

May I also take this opportunity to formally invite you to the *Winterton Junior School Carol Service*, which is to be held on **Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> December** at All Saints Church at 10am.

Although your child should come in their school uniform on **Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> December**, they may bring 'Christmas' type jumpers/T-shirts with them to change into for their *Christmas lunch*, if they so wish. This is entirely optional and your child may stay in their uniform if they prefer.

And finally, on **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December**, the last day of term, your child may bring a board game or toy (NOT electronic) into school to play with however, this is at the child's own risk of loss or damage.
